Lisa Rinna had silicone removed from her trademark lips in August — and allowed cameras to film the ordeal. But she swears it

wasn't for publicity. "I did it for myself," she says.

Below, our experts battle over whether she did it for headlines or her health.

"She took out her lip implants to get attention for her new reality show [*Harry Loves Lisa*]," Cooper Lawrence, fame expert and author of *The Cult of Celebrity*, tells *OK!* "It's a no-brainer! She and her husband [**Harry Hamlin**] had to do something outrageous to promote it."

But board-certified plastic

surgeon Dr. Kevin Brenner (who does not treat Lisa) thinks it's a health issue. "Complications can arise with any injection, but in particular, when it's free silicone," he tells *OK!*, adding that removing silicone is a risky and potentially painful process. "It's not like an implant that you can take right out. It's quite a bit more complicated."



Lisa says the silicone made her lips feel "bumpy and uneven."
