How do you keep your skin flawless?

Every girl should use dry shampoo! You spray it onto your roots to soak up the hair's natural oils. Even when you don't have time to wash your hair, it makes it look like you did. Rene Furterer makes an amazing one — it's the best-kept secret ever!

What's your biggest beauty splurge?

Crème de la Mer moisturizer.

What's your signature scent?

I like strong but feminine perfumes, like Michael Eau de Parfum by Michael Kors. I spray it on my clothes to make it last all day.

If you could use only five products for the rest of your life, what would they be?

Johnson's Baby Lotion — I've been using it since I was a girl and will never stop. Giorgio Armani foundation No. 7 gives great coverage while making skin look luminous. MAC Pink Swoon blush gives cheeks a flirty, healthy flush. MAC Instant Gold lip gloss is what I always wear on the red carpet. And Kiehl's lip balm is so moisturizing.

Do you do any at-home treatments?

I love tweezing my eyebrows at home. I never get them done — I just do them myself. I'm obsessed with Rubis tweezers. They last a long time, and they're sharp and precise.

L&S tip: Artificial lighting casts shadows that can give the appearance of heavier brows, resulting in overplucking. So tweeze in natural, diffused light.

Do you have any secret makeup tricks?
